

Campus Information

University Police – 24 hours response at 716-878-6333

Free Parking – Overnight use lot R-14 (near the barn). Daytime use R-12, R-13, or R-14. The lots are near the back of campus, off of Rockwell Road closer to Grant Street. (See map at <http://suny.buffalostate.edu/campus#maps>.)

CCNY Buildings

- Campbell Student Union – For registration, meals, breaks. Near the center of campus, bordered by open Quad and Plaza spaces.
- Caudell Hall – For all workshop sessions. Near front of campus toward Rockwell and Elmwood, across the Plaza kitty-corner from the Campbell Student Union.
- Student Apartment Complex (“STAC”) – Overnight lodging for guests staying on campus. At the very back of campus on Rees St. (near Grant St and Rockwell Rd).

For all conference attendees

- Conference check-in will be in the upper lobby of the Campbell Student Union.
- Go to the registration table for any questions throughout the conference.
- Your **name tag** will be needed to access meals and events throughout the conference.
- Nearby restaurants and shopping are available within a 10-15 minute walk or short drive down Elmwood Avenue.

For those staying on campus

- Housing Assistants will be available at **the main lobby of STAC** from 9am-11pm to assist with anything guests may need.
- **Conference Assistant on Duty – 716-697-1288** for guest assistance beyond those hours.
- For any emergencies, guests can call **University Police at 716-878-6333**.
- Housing check-in is in the main lobby of STAC starting Tuesday at 4-6:30pm.
- Housing check-out will be Friday between 12-1pm. If a guest has to check out earlier, we can accommodate that request as well by speaking to the Housing Assistant in the lobby.
- Late check-out is available during Saturday until 3pm for those wanting to stay in Buffalo Friday night/Saturday.

WiFi for guests – steps to set up access on your own device(s)

1. Open the WiFi settings on your device and connect to **BengalOpen16**.
 2. Open the web browser on your device and go to **suny.buffalostate.edu**.
 3. When the Welcome to Campus WiFi Network page loads, click on one of the links under **Login as Buffalo State Guest**.
 4. On the next screen, read over the secure WiFi network access policy, click **Continue**.
 5. On the next screen, select **Guest Login**.
 6. On the How to Authenticate Yourself to the System screen, click **Next**.
 7. On the Get/Enter Your Verification Code screen, select either the **Sent To Email** or **Send TXT Message** option and then enter your email address or phone number. Click **Send**.
 8. On the next screen, **enter the verification code** you received in the Verification Code box, click **Continue**.
 9. Click **Download** to download the **NetworkWizardLoader** file to your device, and then open this file to complete setup.
