

Jamie M. Ostrov is a Professor of Psychology in the Clinical Psychology program at the University at Buffalo, The State University of New York. Dr. Ostrov is also the Director of the Social Development Laboratory at the University at Buffalo. As a developmental psychologist, Dr. Ostrov's research focuses on understanding the development of subtypes of aggression in young children.

Dr. Ostrov has published his research in a variety of top peer-reviewed journals including: *Child Development*, *Development & Psychopathology*, and *Psychological Review*. Dr. Ostrov currently serves on 9 editorial boards including: *Aggressive Behavior*, *Child Development*, *Early Childhood Research Quarterly*, *Journal of Applied Developmental Psychology*, *Journal of Clinical Child and Adolescent Psychology*, and *Social Development*. His research is currently funded by the National Science Foundation (NSF) and the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA).

Dr. Ostrov obtained his M.A. and Ph.D. in Child (Developmental) Psychology from the University of Minnesota. He received an M.S.E.d. in Psychological Services from the University of Pennsylvania and completed his B.A. in Psychology (Summa Cum Laude) at Colgate University.
