BETHEL'S HISTORY

by Dr. Monroe Fordham

Bethel A.M.E. Church of Buffalo, New York is one of the oldest congregations in the city. Organized in 1831, the church has a history that predates, by one year, the corporation of the city of Buffalo. During the more than 150 years of its existence, Bethel has established an enviable record of community service and spiritual leadership.

In the years immediately after its founding in 1831, the "Colored Methodist Society" of Buffalo functioned as an independent religious body. In 1836 the "Society" petitioned the New York Annual Conference of the African Methodist Episcopal Church for pastoral care. The New York Annual Conference responded by sending Rev. Richard Williams to Western New York to organize A.M.E. congregations in the region. Rev. Williams formed a 31 member congregation in Buffalo. He also licensed two local preachers. Rev. George Weir, Sr., was the first A.M.E. pastor to be assigned to the Buffalo "station", and was succeeded by the Rev. Thomas W. Jackson in 1847.

During its early years, the Buffalo congregation workshipped in a house in Carroll Street. In 1839 the group moved to a frame building on Vine Street. The original Vine Street Church was replaced with a new brick structure, at a cost of \$3000 in 1845. Shortly after a Rev. Burch, described as a very able minister, was assigned. The Vine Street A.M.E. Church, as it was known during the 19th century, remained on Vine Street until 1928. During that period the following ministers served:

In January 1928, the congregation moved to a building at 551 Eagle Street, where it remained for 25 years before moving to its preent Michigan Avenue location in 1953. In that quarter of a century, Bethel was pastored by the following pastors:

1935 - Rev. Charles Stewart (departed abruptly)

1935 - 1938 Rev. J.A. Portlock

1938 - 1939 Rev. H.P. Anderson

1939 - 1940 Presiding Elder James A. Manning (replaced Rev. Anderson who died suddenly)

1940 - 1941 Rev. William McKinley Dawkins

During the 19th century, several of Bethel's pastors and numerous members were active in the anti-slavery movement. The Vine Street Church and the homes of some of its members were often used as places of refuge for fugitove slaves on the way to Canada. Frederock Douglass William Wells Brown and others, including Pastors of the Vine Street Church, spoke out against slavery and racial caste from the pulpit of the church.

In 1867, Henry Moxley, a trustee of the Vine Street A.M.E. Church, launched a legal attack on Buffalo's segregated school system. Moxley charged the city with violating the federal Civil Rights Act of 1866. The State Supreme Court eventually ruled against Moxley, but the case is significant because it was one of the first school segregation cases to be brought under the 1866 Civil Rights Act.

When the "great migration" began to swell the Afro-American population of Buffalo in the early 20th century, Bethel A.M.E. of Buffalo played an important role in acculturating the newcomers from the south. The 1920's brought many new members and a period of prosperity to Bethel Church. During the 1930s the newcomers joined forces with the "old Bethelites" and together they weathered the hard times of the "great depression".

By the early 1940s, the Afro-American community of Buffalo was beginning to share in the economic prosperity of the WW II industrial production. During the administration of the Rev. D. Ormond Walker (1941-1948), Bethel's membership and financial assets reached new heights. In 1948, Rev. Walker was elected to the Bishopric on the first ballot. Rev. Walker was the first minister to be elected as a Bishop while pastoring at Bethel, Buffalo.

During the post-WW II era, the church continued to move forward and prosper under Revs. John W.P. Collier, Charles E. Stewart, and Harry J. White, Sr. It was under Rev. White, in 1953, that the congregation moved from Eagle Street to its present location. Following Rev. White's 13 year ministry, Bethel was ably led successively by the late Rev. G. Grant Crumpley and Rev. James K. Baldwin.

In its first 150 years, Bethel has made many outstanding contributions in serving the spiritual and social needs of the community. But the congregation does not intend to rest on its past achievements. Under the leadership of its present pastor, Rev. Eugene E. McAshan, Bethel looks to the future with confidence and a determination to build on an already rich legacy.
