



Candace Sherese Michelle Fryer




Candace was born on December 30, 1986 under the sign of Capricom. She weighs 19 lbs. and 10 ozs.

James Howard Hall III




James Howard Hall was born on July 10, 1986, under the sign Cancer. He is fourteen months old.

Whitney Kenita Goggins-Sherod




Whitney was born on January 16, 1986 under the sign of Capricorn. She weighed in at 9 lbs, 3 ozs. She is now twenty months old.
