

OBITUARY

Mrs. Ruby P. Brown, born Ruby Bay to Frank and Tenza Bay March 11, 1905 in Andrews, South Carolina, departed this life on Sunday, January 22, 1984 in the Deaconess Hospital at 8:25 AM.

She is survived by her husband, Melvin L. Brown, who she married in August of 1933. They moved to Buffalo in 1942 and shortly thereafter joined Bethel A.M.E. Church and have been a member since that time.
