

Lily Mae Harrison was one of nine children born in Alabama to the union of the Smith family. She united in Holy Matrimony with Alexander Harrison who preceded her in death. She moved to Buffalo, New York at a very early age.

Lily Mae Harrison United with Bethel African Methodist Episcopal Church under the Pastorate of the late Reverend M.E. Jackson. She served the church as a Stewardess and later became one of the first three woman appointed to the Steward Board. She organized the "King's Daughters" and served as it's president for 35 years and illness overtook her.
