OBITUARY



Flora McClendon Brown was born in Graceville, Florida on September 12, 1917 to Jim and Cora Blount McClendon. She joined Salem A.M.E. Church in Graceville, Florida at an early age. She traveled from Florida to Niagara Falls, New York in the early '40's and joined St. John's A.M.E. Church. At St. John's she was very active in the Sunday School and in the Building Fund campaign for the new church which was erected on Garden Avenue. Later she moved to Buffalo and joined Bethel A.M.E. Church under the leadership of Reverend Harry J. White. While at Bethel she was active in various organizations including the Gospel Chorus, Sunday School, Bethel Credit Union and the Missionary Society, where she served as Chairperson of the "Here Am I Unit" until September, 1983.
