

OBITUARY

With the same gentleness that he lived, Manning Fogan entered into the fuller life with God on Saturday morning the 10th day of May, 1986 at the Veteran's Hospital, Buffalo, New York.

Manning Fogan was born to the late Sam and Iler Fogan in Marion, S.C. on December 8, 1922 one of nine children. Two sisters, Mrs. Sally Ellerby and Mae Ida have preceded him in death. As a young person, he learned to serve the Lord faithfully with his family at the Springville M.E. Church.

He served his country in the European theater of war during World War II and received an honorable discharge. He was united in holy matrimony with Agnes Grice December 2, 1950 in Marion. They became parents of two children, Manning, II and Sandra Yvonne. Manning's love for his children, his eight god-children, as well as those belonging to other parents, is best exemplified by his strong attachment to their well-being and development. He stood with many youths through their trials and tribulations and helped them to see the light.

Of his thirty-five years as a resident of Buffalo, thirty-three of them were spent in the employ of Bethlehem Steel, retiring in 1984.

He became a member of Bethel AME Church in 1956 under the pastorate of the Reverend Harry J. White, Sr., and established an ongoing record to the Senior Board of Stewards; the Male Usher Board, and a devoted Lay Org. member. Until illness overtook him, he volunteered as a driver for Meals on Wheels.
