# 4. New Student Orientation:

  - i. Union membership takes 2% of your paycheck, about \$4-5
  - ii. Provide representation, contract negotiation (including health insurance, raises, fee waivers)
  - iii. Becoming a member entitles you to vote on the TA contract you sign, which is being re-negotiated in the next year.
  - iv. Current goals include statewide fee abolition, \$20k stipend for all graduate students, paid maternity leave
