We are seeking a Graduate Intern to support the year-end assessment and reporting of these grant initiatives. This role will also assist with participant outreach and support.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Assist with assessment, reporting, and communication of impacts and outcomes
- Review and analyze aggregated data set to identify patterns of potential interest
- Analyze quantitative data, thematically code qualitative data, create charts and graphs
- Asist with participant recruitment and outreach
- Communicate with participants to encourage project completion
- Maintain related databases and virtual records

Skills and Requirements

Required:

- Fully matriculated in a graduate degree program at UB
- Full-time graduate student, maintaining a minimum of nine (9) credits per semester
- Good academic standing during the current academic year
- Experience creating data visualizations and analyzing qualitative and quantitative data

- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail
