- 4. Report of the President
  - GSA President Isaac Kolding makes everyone aware the Whistleblower and Conflict of Interest policies that were distributed in the meeting packet.
    - Verification of receipt of these policies needs to be received by the October 2<sup>nd</sup> Board meeting

- Updated GSA Alcohol Policy
  - o Isaac explains that the policy needed to be updated to keep students safe and to protect the organization from legal liability issues.
  - o Clubs cannot directly serve alcohol, it must be served by a third-party vendor.
    - Example: Clubs are not permitted to purchase beer at Wegman's and serve it at a club picnic. Clubs may not sponsor BYOB events or invite attendees to bring alcohol.
  - o Open bars are not permitted. Two drink max per person at all club-sponsored events.
  - o On campus events with alcohol must use Three Pillars Catering, as per University policy.
  - o Isaac opens discussion and questions from the Board are addressed.
- Updates on the CAS Dean Search
  - Current Dean, Robin Schulze, has resigned. The search committee will be holding a student input meeting this Friday from 1:00 1:30pm online where students can voice opinions and concerns about what type of person they want to see in her replacement. - PhD Excellence Oversight Committee Call for Volunteer
  - Committee is mostly composed of faculty, but there are administrative and graduate student reps as well. Meetings happen once per month and last approximately 1-1.5 hours. - Update on Policy Review Group (PRG) for Assembling, Posting and Camping policies
  - o GSA Executive Board met with President Tripathi over the summer and advocated for a spot on this committee, which was granted. This all results from the protest issues that occurred last May, so the University is revising their policies. There is now a 30-day open review and comment period, so if you would like to submit any feedback please be sure to get it submitted within the comment window. Isaac shares the link to the policies and comment forum. All comments submitted through official channels are addressed at each committee meeting. These policies cannot be enacted until the 30-day review window closes, so please make sure to submit feedback ASAP.

    - Budget will be frozen by the University (not GSA) for the entire year if this is not completed on time.
- Mandatory Officer Training for all club Presidents and Treasurers
  - Officers should review all of the required materials and then must pass a quiz.
  - Passed Quiz Results must be received from all club Presidents and Treasurers by the September 30th paperwork deadline or club funds will be frozen.
