# 4. Report of the President

- GSA President Isaac Kolding discusses the Services Committee's Conference Funding Report
  - Students estimate overall funding need at \$2,800 (master's) and \$4,200 (PhDs)
  - Availability of funding varies widely by school, degree type, and department
  - On average and from all sources, graduate students receive enough funding to attend at least one academic or professional conference
  - GSA rejects very few conference funding applications; students often decline to use awarded funding
  - Some incremental changes may increase expenditures
  - The GSA E-board will review and discuss the report and notify the Board of any proposed changes to policies or the budget.

#### 5. Report of the Vice President

- GSA Vice President Sarah MacDougall reminds clubs that they <u>must</u> be sharing information about club meeting times with all graduate student members, and not just sharing the meeting minutes. Club officers alone cannot make decisions on behalf of the club, and wider advertising of club meetings might help alleviate the quorum issues that many of our clubs have been facing recently.
- This is the last Board meeting of the year at which clubs can be recognized, so all new club requests will have to wait until Fall, 2025.

- GSA Treasurer Tamara Grosso discusses funding account balances
  - We have one funding request this month, so balances are as follows:
    - Special Activity: (updated balance) \$10,000.00 to start; \$0.00 recommended this month; \$7,650.00 remaining
    - Interdepartmental Activity: (updated balance) \$3,000.00 to start; \$0.00 recommended; \$3,000.00 remaining
    - Symposium: (updated balance) \$10,000.00 to start; \$0.00 recommended; \$8,600.00 remaining
    - Scholarly publication: (updated balance) \$6,000.00 to start; \$1,475.00 recommended; \$4,525.00 remaining
    - Community outreach: (updated balance) \$3,000.00 to start; \$0.00 recommended; \$3,000.00 remaining

- Updated beginning balance: \$225,000.00; Remaining balance: \$163,865.66
