- 6. Report of the Treasurer
 - GSA Treasurer, Isaac Kolding, reports the GSA funding account balances
 - There are no funding requests up for approval this month, so balances are as follows:
 - Special Activity: \$10,000 to start; \$1,200 recommended this month; \$6,490 remaining
 - Interdepartmental Activity: \$3,000 to start; \$0 recommended this month; \$3,000 remaining
 - Symposium: \$10,000 to start; \$1,400 recommended this month; \$8,600 remaining

- Scholarly Publication: \$6,000 to start; \$3,000 recommended this month; \$3,000 remaining
- Community Outreach: \$3,000 to start; \$0 recommended this month; \$3,000 remaining
- Conference Funding
 - 20 requests were received in December for \$10,749.54; 19 were approved for \$10,474.54
 - 1 request was withdrawn
 - o Beginning balance: \$225,000.00; Remaining balance: \$128,972.98
- Community Outreach Highlight
 - Isaac reminds everyone that the Community Outreach fund was created to promote service to local community
 agencies for the betterment of humanity and to encourage graduate student organization involvement in the
 community.
 - o Clubs can get a \$250 budget increase by doing 40 hours of community service to a local non-profit. The 40 hours is cumulative, so that can be 40 people doing 1 hour of volunteer work, or 10 people doing 4 hours of volunteer work.
