Plant Descriptions and Care

ASSORTED ANNUALS:

GERANIUMS:

	A garden standard, hardy sun tolerant. Keep them deadheaded and they will bloom all season long.
Bacopa	Full sun, long lasting cascading stems of tiny white blooms. Keep evenly watered.
Shade Impatiens	They love the shade, do not over water, will mound and bloom all season.
Dahlia	Full sun, full flowers.
New Guinea Impatiens	Best in am sun, pm shade. Will wilt in hot sun. Keep watered.
Sweet Potato Vine	Great accent plant, viney habit will hang over window boxes and planters. Available in lime green or black. Very little care needed. Sun or Shade.
Million Bells	Full sun. A small version of Petunia, that does not need deadheading, yet blooms all season.
Wave Petunia	Full sun. A crawling, hanging version of Petunia, prolific bloomer. Heavy feeder. Will attract hummingbirds.
Spikes, vinca, Licorice	Full sun. All will go well with other annuals to accent the baskets, planters.
Sunpatiens	A new hybridized version of New Guinea Impatiens that will tolerate full sun. Still needs lots of water to maintain its health. Showy flowers, disease resistant.
Dragon Wing Begonia	Part Shade. Glossy wing shaped leaves, small flowers, will attract hummingbirds. Do not over water or water the foliage of this plant.
Ivy Geranium	Full Sun. Glossy leaves, smaller flowers than standard Geraniums, has a hanging growth habit. Keep deadheaded.
Marigolds	Full Sun. Bright orange and yellow colors by variety. May repel rabbits out of garden.
Petunia-Double Mix	Full Sun. Double layers of ruffled petals. Will attract butterflies and hummingbirds. Fragrant, needs to be deadheaded.
Petunia-Picotee Mix	Full Sun. Many vibrant colors, with white edges, need to be deadheaded.

PERENNIALS

Agastache	Hummingbirds, fragrant, native plant, gray-green foliage with spike blooms on long stems blooms late spring to frost.
Coreopsis	Sun. Easy grow native plant. Deer resistant, butterflies. Summer long blooms.
Gaillardia	Sun. Blanket Flower. Long blooming daisy like flowers, butterflies.
Huchera	Part Sun. (Coral Bells) Easy to grow native plant. Drought tolerant.
Rudebeckia	Sun. (Black Eyed Susan) Tall daisy like yellow, gold flowers with black centers. Hummingbirds butterflies. Will self-seed and multiply.
Creeping Phlox	Sun. Low growing border plant. Blooms early spring for 4 weeks, then only green mounds.
Garden Phlox	Sun. Tall upright fragrant flowers. Deadhead to promote more blooms. Hummingbirds & butterflies.
Clematis	Vine with large purple or pink flowers. Can be trained over arbors or trellises.

HERBS

All herbs do best in full sun and minimal water.

TOMATO

Cherry	Small, delicious, great in salads
Beefsteak	Traditional large slicing
Early Girl	The first of the eating tomatos to ripen

PEPPERS

Lady Bell	Traditional green pepper
Hungarian Hot Pepper	
Hungarian Sweet Pepper	

LETTUCE

Butter Crunch	Nice, sweet, green variety
Red Leaf	Red ruffled variety
