What We Carry will lift up four women immigrants and descendants of immigrants to tell their stories. Coming from different areas of the globe, with widely divergent traditions and expectations, these women and their foremothers have all made a new life in Buffalo. These personal stories reflect on what these women or their ancestors carried with them to Buffalo and how they carry on their family legacy today.

The goal of the event is to show everyone that everyone has an immigration story from when their family came to the United States. Even if your ancestors were natives to the United States or were brought here forcibly, your family is bound to still carry something with them from their past. Whether it is a physical item, a practice, an idea or a tradition, we all carry something with us.

After the conclusion of the event, the goal is to host additional follow-up events and programs to allow guests to share their own immigration stories throughout the year, building community and continuing the dialogue.
