UBWC Book Club Update

The traditional UBWC book club led by Carolyn Giambra and Lois Kelly has been ON HOLD for the 2020/21 program year. It looks like our traditional monthly gatherings at Canterbury Woods Club House from September to May will continue to be ON HOLD for some or all of the 2021/22 year as well.

We did experiment with converting the book club to a Zoom format this past year with good success. Two discussion groups were organized with a maximum of 15 members per group to meet either the second Monday or Tuesday of each month from December 2020 to April 2021. The five women who led the discussions for each book presented their programs for both groups. Informal feedback from members was positive. Discussion was comfortable with 15 or less participants and some felt they had more opportunities to share thoughts than in the traditional group.

Moving forward to the 2021/22 program year for UBWC, our best option is to continue with the Zoom format. University at Buffalo Women's Club Reverse Raffle Official Rules

Unlike a typical raffle, in a Reverse Raffle the purchaser of the last ticket drawn wins the Grand Prize.

- The event will take place on the UB campus via Zoom with UB Women's Club Board members running the drawing. Ticket holders do NOT need to be present on Zoom to win. Winners will be notified via email or phone after the drawing.
- Reverse Raffle tickets cost \$50.00 each. The cost of the raffle ticket is not deductible as a charitable donation.
- You must be 18 years or older to purchase a ticket.
