In September Kid's Art Supplies were collected and the following agencies benefited from our generosity: The Boys & Girls Club of Holland NY – Elaine Lydon of the BFWC Board and I traveled to Holland and donated many bags and boxes of Art Supplies to Paige, the Director. It was very timely as she was in the midst of filling back packs with new school and art supplies for returning students.

The following week I visited the YWCA on Grant St., in Buffalo with the next donation. They were the recipients of many bags of new Art supplies consisting of colored pencils, crayons, paint sets and construction paper. This facility houses children of all ages during the day while their parents are appearing in the court systems. They were overjoyed to receive so many new items for the kids.

Then on to Family Promise Center on Hickory St. in Buffalo where they coordinate the needs of homeless families and assists with finding suitable housing and furnishing it with the basic necessities. Luanne, the Director, promptly put the Art supply donations into operation entertaining the kids while their parents were completing intake paperwork.

More art donations were delivered to the Holy Cross Head Start Program on Maryland St., in Buffalo, to an after-school program at City Mission on Main St., in Buffalo and my final stop at the newly opened Boys & Girls Club of Cheektowaga located in a former school near St. Joe's Hospital.

There were many hugs, tears of joy and sincere thank-you's as the donations were unloaded from my car and given to the various agencies. Please know how much your generosity was appreciated!

During October a multitude of personal care items and toiletries were collected and found a new home at places including the Family Help Center on Dingens St. in Cheektowaga, enjoyed at Plymouth Crossroads, a homeless shelter for youth, located in West Seneca, at the Burrito Brigade at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Eggertsville whose young people took the toiletries along with the burritos they made to the homeless families living in downtown Buffalo.

Our good works continue in November and December by collecting new children's PJ's and underwear, boys and girls in sizes 7-14. I am looking forward to hearing from you!
